EMERGENCY OVERVIEW

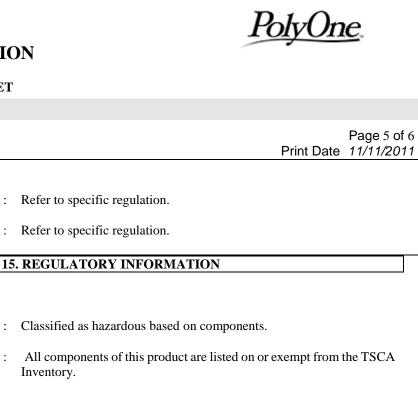
